

Honor Flight Southeastern North Carolina – Fundraiser Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in fundraising for Honor Flight of Southeastern North Carolina (HFSENC). Your help is invaluable as we spread the word of our mission to serve every WWII veteran in Southeastern North Carolina. We appreciate your help and support!

In order to sanction your fundraiser as an official Honor Flight of Southeastern North Carolina event – and to add your event to our website and calendar and so that your efforts help to fly more veterans to Washington, you and your organization and any representatives or volunteers involved with the event must adhere to the following requirements:

1. Complete the Fundraiser Registration form and fax to (910) 395-4608 or e-mail to fundraising@honorflightsenc.org.
2. Fundraising programs **not** approved by HFSENC include:
 - a. Gambling
 - b. The selling of alcohol or tobacco where the primary source of donations is the selling of these products.
 - c. Selling of merchandise or services by a for-profit third party, where only a percentage or amount of the sale goes to HFSENC.
3. Include the Official HFSENC logo on all advertisements, signs, posters and/or web listings publicizing your fundraiser. A digital copy of our logo is available by sending an e-mail request for .jpg or .pdf files to fundraising@honorflightsenc.org or by calling (910) 874-VETS (8387).
4. Conduct the event in a manner that will reflect positively on Honor Flight Southeastern North Carolina and the Honor Flight Network and most especially our WWII Veterans. Be aware that all activities and events associated with your fundraising event are to be respectful of your community's morals, and must not reflect negatively on any individuals or organizations.
5. All proceeds of fundraisers benefiting Honor Flight of Southeastern North Carolina must go exclusively to Honor Flight of Southeastern North Carolina. Proceeds should be forwarded to your event coordinator (Honor Flight of Southeastern North Carolina Board Member ONLY), who will also be your POC at Honor Flight of Southeastern North Carolina. Proceeds should be delivered to your POC within 72 hours of the completion of event, in check form (made payable to Honor Flight of Southeastern North Carolina) or cash.
6. It is a great idea to involve WWII Veterans to your event; our efforts are on their behalf.
7. Honor Flight of Southeastern North Carolina at its sole discretion will support your event with participation including promotional items and flyers, advertisement, event calendar listings on our website and any other opportunities our budget allows.
